All incoming second years, third year and sixth year students have their new lockers for August return.

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The current first years/incoming second years, current second years/incoming third years and the current fifth years/ incoming sixth years received their new lockers and therefore they have a secure storage area for their books during the summer holidays.

Due to State Examinations and building works access to these lockers is impossible until the new school year in August so if your child has books at home please keep them safely for the return in August unless they are needed by me for incoming classes as outlined in the following slides.

All books are returned to the Library area in the new building.

Transition year students - any books left to be returned please return any time from 6th June to 9th June from 8.30am-4pm.

In case any student has not returned Transition year books please return-English novels as well as Gafa along with the four core books for German, English, Work Experience and Irish.

First year -books to return- All other books are in new locker for August return.

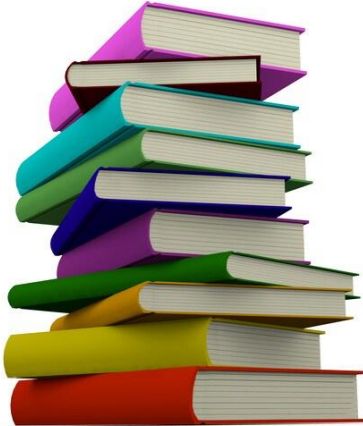
1. **Maths** book 1 Text and Tests.

3. **Irish** the textbook only TURAS 1, please keep the workbook.
4. **English** -Kingdom 1 text only, please keep the workbook.

In case anyone did not return these before 2nd June please do so any time from 8.30am -4pm from Tuesday 6th to Friday 9th June.

Second year-books to be returned.

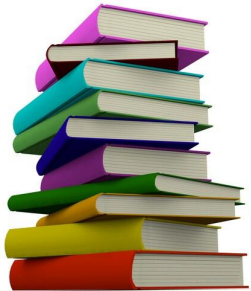
1. **Minding Me 2 – SPHE**

In case any second year student finds this book at home please bring it to the new library any day from Tuesday 6th to Friday 9th June from 8.30-4pm



Fifth year students have lockers for sixth year.

No books to be returned as all in lockers for sixth year. If a student was absent in the final days of school then keep school books safely at home until we are back in August please.



All Third year books are to be returned after each exam.

Third year students should return books as they do each exam please.

CPSE -Take a stand textbook- already returned if not please bring in first week of the exams.

SPHE - Minding Me 3- already returned if not please bring in first week of the exams.

If you are finished with studied novels please return those also please. Dictionaries or log tables are to be returned if they are book rental resources.

Exam subjects - Keep those until each exam is over and return that day to the New library area just before you go to the exam centre for morning and afternoon exams.

The books are returned to the Library as each exam is done so that by the final day of the exam only the books for that final subject are left to be handed back.

Irish workbooks, Making History skills book, Cyclone skills book, Business studies skills book and Graphics A3 book are not returned as you will have written into those resources.(only textbooks needed not workbooks please)

Sixth year book scheme

Books are returned to the library area as each exam is done.

Morning exams;

Books for morning exams can be left back to the new library area just before you go to the exam centre.

Afternoon exams;

You can drop books back at lunch break before you return to the exam centres for the exams scheduled in the afternoon.

Third years and Sixth years who have book resources.

All exam students at junior cycle and senior cycle who have book borrowings to be returned will receive a printed list of the books on loan as they return the first book to the new library area this is to help you see what is left to be returned.
