UNIFORM POLICY

Our school requires that all students adhere to our uniform guidelines. These guidelines require that all students present themselves neatly and in full school uniform. Regular uniform checks will be carried out.

Uniform Requirements

- Green school jumper with St. Colman's Community College crest.
- Grey and white striped school shirt.
- Grey (Charcoal) school skirt of an appropriate length
- Grey (Charcoal) school trousers.
- For girls black opaque tights.
- Full black leather or leather type shoes with no coloured markings or stripes.
- A school coat or plain black coat only policy (no coloured markings/ stripes etc)
- PE Uniform to include a school half zip top, tracksuit pants and school jersey style t-shirt (compulsory for years 1,2,3,4 in 2025/2026). The school tracksuit is optional for years 5 & 6 for the 2025/2026 academic year.
- On the day that students in years 1,2,3 & 4 have PE, a full school tracksuit must be worn coming to school.
- On the day that year 5 & 6 have PE, full regular school uniform must be worn coming to school. The student is to bring appropriate PE gear, i.e, tracksuit bottoms, a t- shirt with sleeves and runners to change into and out of for the PE class. If a year 5 or 6 student opts to buy the tracksuit this may be worn to school on PE days.
- We operate a school coat/plain black coat only policy in our school. (no coloured markings/ stripes etc) We strongly recommend the school coat / school fleece. There are two school coat options and a school fleece option available from uniform suppliers.

I agree to the following:

- The uniform will be worn to school every day including school outings and will be maintained in neat condition.
- The school shirt will be worn and be visible at all times. A plain white t-shirt (no logos) may be worn under the shirt no other colour.
- School jumpers will be worn to school every morning.
- School skirts and trousers will not be in stretch fabric.
- Full school tracksuit will be worn for PE classes by years 1,2,3 & 4 for the 2025/2026 academic year.
- Suitable and appropriate sports clothing ie tracksuit pants/sports shorts, a t-shirt with sleeves and runners) will be worn for PE by years 5 & 6. (Nike Pro or similar styles, short crop t shirts/tops are not permitted)
- I understand that non uniform items may be confiscated.
- I accept the sanctions which will be imposed if I do not adhere to the uniform policy.

If a student is not in full school uniform

- The student will receive a uniform note/sticker in his/her journal.
- Parents/guardians will be contacted to bring the appropriate uniform to the school
- Where a uniform/item of uniform is not available from the parent/guardian or the parent/guardian are uncontactable the student will be loaned the appropriate item of school uniform.
- Refusal to wear the loaned item will result in a lunchtime detention.
- The student should come to school in full uniform the next day.
- Where the non wearing of uniform is persistent the parent/guardian of the student will be contacted by telephone and asked to attend a meeting with the relevant Year Head.
- Ongoing refusal to wear the full school uniform may result in a one day suspension.
